**GAME DAY OPERATIONS**  
COVID Exposure Control Plan

**The following protocols apply to all Game Day's for all age groups (U8 - Adult)**

**1. HEALTH ASSESSMENT FORM / CONTACT TRACING**

It is **MANDATORY** that **all players, coaches and spectators** of the HOME team (ASA or FVS), attending for a game at any game day venue in Abbotsford complete the appropriate Health Assessment Form.

**\*\* AWAY team players, coaches and spectators should be reminded to complete their own clubs' Health Assessment Form, they DO NOT need to complete the ASA or FVS forms.**

**2. SPECTATORS**

- As per the Provincial Health Order (Nov 19, 2020) **NO SPECTATORS** are allowed at games.

**3. FIELD MANAGEMENT**

- Teams (Player & Coaches) should establish safe entry / exit points at each game day field, in order to remain safely within their respective cohort group, especially if you are entering a field that may be occupied prior to your use.
- It is recommended that at fields with only one entry / exit gate, that the visiting team is allowed to leave the field first, followed by the ASA or FVS home team.
- The ASA provides the following guidance as it relates to these venues;

<b>FIELD</b>	<b>ENTER</b>	<b>EXIT</b>
<b>ABBY SNR TURF FIELD</b>	<b>South West or South East gates</b> (grass field side)	<b>Centre field gate</b> (near parking lot)
<b>MRC # 2</b>	<b>South Central gate</b> (gate near mini-fields)	<b>South East corner</b> (closest to W.J Mouat school)
<b>MRC # 4</b>	<b>East gate</b> (closest to W.J Mouat school)	<b>West gate</b> (closest to Rec Centre)
<b>EXHIBITION PARK FIELD # 2 (SOUTH EAST)</b>	<b>East side of Field</b> (nearest path/housing)	<b>West side of field</b> (Between #2 & #3)
<b>EXHIBITION PARK FIELD # 3 (SOUTH WEST)</b>	<b>West side of field</b> (nearest Rotary Stadium/building)	<b>East side of field</b> (Between #2 & #3)

#### 4. TEAM/PLAYER MANAGEMENT

- Players & team staff must use hand sanitizer prior to the start of warm-up – **MANDATORY**.
- Players must supply their own water/drinks bottle and NOT share with others.
- No handshakes or high-fives at any point, and specifically none at the game's conclusion or the scoring of a goal.
- Substitutes are encouraged to remain 6 feet apart on the bench. Face coverings are **MANDATORY**.
- Coaches/managers situated on the sideline close to the team bench are encouraged to remain 6 feet apart and it is **MANDATORY** to wear a face covering.
- Team staff members attending to injured player **MUST** wear a **face covering** AND **gloves** - **MANDATORY**.

#### 5. POST GAME CONSIDERATIONS

- Teams are asked to clean up all debris from the bench area and leave clean for the next team/game.
- Teams are asked to vacate the bench area as quickly & efficiently as possible, after their game, so that the next team can access the area.
- Any/all post-game debriefs should take place away from the field of play/bench areas.
- Players & team staff must use hand sanitizer prior to leaving the field – **MANDATORY**

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- Failure to comply with the above requirements may result in a player/spectator being removed from the field/game.
- This is a living document that may be amended from time to time and which ensures that ASA remains compliant with the latest health and safety requirements, as it pertains to COVID-19 and any other safety issues.
- This document may be updated and reposted without notice. It is incumbent on the members of ASA to ensure they are aware of the latest policies.
